Partnership for Success Fifth Grade's Expectations

- ? The fourth and fifth grade team has developed consistent expectations for learning and behavior, including a system of rewards and consequences. These are specifically related to the work and social habit card.
- ? Our goal is by the end of fourth/fifth grade, ALL children will be on or above grade level in reading and math.
- ? The target instructional reading level = 28 (end of fourth grade) and target instructional reading level = 30 (end of fifth grade)
- ? The target reading fluency rate = 100 words per minute
- ? The target memorization of addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division facts = 100 problems in 5 minutes.
- ? The target for orally responding to a math fact = 2 seconds
- ? The target for a written response to a math fact = 3 seconds
- ? The target math benchmark score for January and May = 80% or higher
- ? The target for Maryland School Assessment = proficient or advanced in reading and math
- ? Read 25 books
